Top Tips for writing a clear and interesting label

Your **label** can be long or short, it's up to you but make sure it helps make your picture special.

If you need help ask a grown up to write down your ideas

It's always good to plan what you are going to say about your picture.

- What your photo or drawing is about.
- Why you chose it or drew it
- What it shows about kindness and how it makes you feel.
- Don't forget capital letters and full stops.
- Use words like **then, if, that and because** to join your sentences.

Read it aloud to yourself, that way you'll know if it needs to be better.

If you are happy with your label, now is a good time to type it up, or ask a grown up to help.

Always check spelling and punctuation. Fingers crossed all correct.

Lastly ask a grown up to read it and check for mistakes.
